The artist is best known for her deceptively simple text paintings, offering witty puns that suggest Groucho Marx as a linguistics scholar. In this entertaining show of fifty small collages and one large wall drawing, Rosen tampers with found objects to equally droll effect. A Helmut Lang flyer now reads Helmut Language.
