## 15. See Hugh Steers: The Nullities of Life

Curators rush in.

At the time of his death — from AIDS-related complications at 32 — in 1995, Hugh Steers was known as a deeply whimsical and mystical figurative painter of private life and sexual innuendo, rendered in a smoldering, glowing palette of golden sienna and rosy flesh and set in oddly tilted, vertiginous, closed-in spaces. There's heartbreak and delight in these condensed scenarios of love, loss, and aloneness — enough to suggest several small museum surveys to reveal the secrets of this special artist.
